# Carbohydrate Binding Module 42D, Clostridium thermocellum



#### **Description**

Carbohydrate Binding Module 42D (CBM42) is a Carbohydrate Binding Protein originating from *Clostridium thermocellum*. The recombinant CBM42, purified from *Escherichia coli*, is a single-domain protein belonging to the Carbohydrate Binding Module family 42 (CBM42, see more details at <a href="https://www.cazy.org">www.cazy.org</a>). The protein is supplied in a solution containing 35 mM NaHepes buffer (pH 7.5), 750 mM NaCl, 200 mM Imidazole, 3.5 mM CaCl<sub>2</sub>, and 25% (v/v) glycerol, at a concentration of 1 mg/mL. #### **Electrophoretic Purity**

The molecular integrity and purity of CBM42 were evaluated using sodium dodecyl sulfate-polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis (SDS-PAGE), followed by BlueSafe staining (MB15201) (Figure 1).



**Figure 1**. SDS-PAGE analysis of CBM42 was conducted in (Lane 1), employing a 14% polyacrylamide gel. The enzyme exhibits a band corresponding to a molecular weight of approximately 18,99 kDa. Lane M contains a Protein Marker for reference.

#### **Storage temperature**

The protein should be stored at -30°C to -15°C in a constant temperature freezer. The protein will remain stable till the expiry date if stored as specified.

### **Ligand specificity**

CBM42 binds to decorated and undecorated 1,4-β-xylans and arabinogalactans.
