Chondroitin AC lyase 8A, Pedobacter heparinus

Description

Chondroitin AC lyase 8A (PhCac8A), assigned the E.C. number 4.2.2.5, is a derivative of $Pedobacter\ heparinus$. It is an enzyme that participates in the eliminative degradation of polysaccharides containing 1,4- β -D-hexosaminyl and 1,3- β -D-glucuronosyl linkages to disaccharides containing 4-deoxy- β -D-gluc-4-enuronosyl groupsanhydrobond in the MurNAc residue. The recombinant PhCac8A, purified from $Escherichia\ coli$, is a single-domain Pectate Lyase family 8 (PL8) enzyme (see more details at www.cazy.org). The protein is supplied in a solution containing 35 mM NaHepes buffer (pH 7.5), 750 mM NaCl, 200 mM Imidazole, 3.5 mM CaCl₂, and 25% (v/v) glycerol, at a concentration of 0.5 mg/mL. Electrophoretic Purity




Figure 1. SDS-PAGE analysis of *Ph*Cac8A (PL8) was conducted in (Lane 1), employing a 14% polyacrylamide gel. The enzyme exhibits a band corresponding to a molecular weight of approximately 79,35 kDa. Lane M contains a Protein Marker for reference.

The molecular integrity and purity of *Ph*Cac8A (PL8) were evaluated using sodium dodecyl sulfate-polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis (SDS-PAGE), followed by BlueSafe staining (MB15201) (Figure 1).

Storage temperature

The protein should be stored at -30°C to -15°C in a constant temperature freezer. The protein will remain stable till the expiry date if stored as specified.

Substrate specificity

PhCac8A (PL8) participates in the eliminative cleavage of chondroitin sulfate C (CS-C).

Temperature and pH optima

The enzyme exhibits optimal activity within a pH range of 6.5-7.5 and at a temperature of 40°C. Maximal enzymatic activity is achieved at pH 6.8 and a consistent temperature of 40°C.

Enzyme activity

The substrate specificity and kinetic properties of *Ph*Cac8A (PL8) are detailed in the referenced publication provided below. To perform enzyme assays and determine specific activity values, adhere to the methodology outlined in the cited paper(s).
