# β-Glucosidase 3A, Ruminococcus albus



#### Description

 $\beta$ -Glucosidase 3A (*Ra*Bgl3A), assigned the E.C. number 3.2.1.21, is a derivative of *Ruminococcus albus*. It is a 1,4- $\beta$ -glucosidase. The recombinant *Ra*Bgl3A, purified from *Escherichia coli*, is a single-domain Glycoside Hydrolase family 3 (GH3) enzyme (see more details at <u>www.cazy.org</u>). The protein is supplied in a solution containing 35 mM NaHepes buffer (pH 7.5), 750 mM NaCl, 200 mM Imidazole, 3.5 mM CaCl<sub>2</sub>, and 25% (v/v) glycerol, at a concentration of 0.5 mg/mL. ### **Electrophoretic Purity**

The molecular integrity and purity of *Ra*Bgl3A (GH3) were evaluated using sodium dodecyl sulfate-polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis (SDS-PAGE), followed by BlueSafe staining (MB15201) (Figure 1).



**Figure 1**. SDS-PAGE analysis of *Ra*BgI3A (GH3) was conducted in (Lane 1), employing a 14% polyacrylamide gel. The enzyme exhibits a band corresponding to a molecular weight of approximately 106,3 kDa. Lane M contains a Protein Marker for reference.

#### Storage temperature

The protein should be stored at -30°C to -15°C in a constant temperature freezer. The protein will remain stable till the expiry date if stored as specified.

#### Substrate specificity

*Ra*Bgl3A (GH3) hydrolyses cellobiose and G3, G3, G5 and G6 oligosaccharides and the artificial substrate 4-nitrophenyl-β-D-glucopyranoside (PNPG).

#### Temperature and pH optima

The enzyme exhibits optimal activity within a pH range of 6.5-7.5 and at a temperature of 30°C. Maximal enzymatic activity is achieved at pH 6.5 and a consistent temperature of 30°C.

## **Enzyme activity**

The substrate specificity and kinetic properties of *Ra*Bgl3A (GH3) are detailed in the referenced publication provided below. To perform enzyme assays and determine specific activity values, adhere to the methodology outlined in the cited paper(s).
