Description

α -Galactosaminogalactan hydrolase 166A (*PtEga166A*), assigned the E.C. number 3.2.1.-, is a derivative of *Pseudomonas thermotolerans*. It is a 1,4- α -galactosaminogalactan hydrolase. The recombinant *PtEga166A*, purified from *Escherichia coli*, is a single-domain Glycoside Hydrolase family 166 (GH166) enzyme (see more details at www.cazy.org). The protein is supplied in a solution containing 35 mM NaHepes buffer (pH 7.5), 750 mM NaCl, 200 mM Imidazole, 3.5 mM CaCl₂, and 25% (v/v) glycerol, at a concentration of 1 mg/mL. Electrophoretic Purity

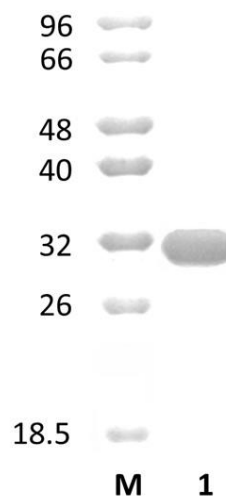


Figure 1. SDS-PAGE analysis of *PtEga166A* (GH166) was conducted in (Lane 1), employing a 14% polyacrylamide gel. The enzyme exhibits a band corresponding to a molecular weight of approximately 30,44 kDa. Lane M contains a Protein Marker for reference.

The molecular integrity and purity of *PtEga166A* (GH166) were evaluated using sodium dodecyl sulfate-polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis (SDS-PAGE), followed by BlueSafe staining (MB15201) (Figure 1).

Storage temperature

The protein should be stored at -30°C to -15°C in a constant temperature freezer. The protein will remain stable till the expiry date if stored as specified.

Temperature and pH optima

The pH optimum for enzymatic activity is 7 while temperature optimum is 37 °C.

Specific activity

PtEga166A (GH166) has shown the ability to promote a 50.0% biofilm biomass reduction in *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*'s biofilm degradation assays.
